GET-RICH-QUICK SCHEMES STOPPED

FTC announced that it has stopped a get-rich-quick scheme that promised investors a 10% return on their investment. The scheme, known as the "10% Return" scheme, was operated by a company called "10% Return" and was based in the state of Florida. The scheme involved investors providing their personal information to the company, which then promised them a 10% return on their investment. The company used this information to contact investors and solicit them to invest. The company then used the investors' money to pay out the promised returns. The FTC has now announced that it has stopped the scheme and has issued a cease and desist order to the company.

HYPED HEALTH CLAIMS
