**PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR AN ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE WHY DEFENDANTS  
SHOULD NOT BE FOUND IN CONTEMPT FOR VIOLATING  
THE STIPULATED JUDGMENT AND ORDER FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

Plaintiff Federal Trade Commission (“FTC” or “Commission”), moves this Court for an Order requiring the above-captioned defendants to appear and show cause why they should not be found in contempt for violating this Court’s Stipulated Judgment and Order For Permanent Injunction (“2001 Order”) entered on March 1, 2001.

The above-captioned defendants and their d/b/a’s are engaged in precisely the same deceptive and misleading practices that led to the FTC’s original action. Defendants practices violate the FTC Act, and of course, the 2001 Order itself, and have resulted in consumer injury.
