## **ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

On Novembe 17, 2011, the Edeal Trade Commission issued the Administrative Complaint in this matter, having eason to believe that Responds OSF HelthcareSystem ("OSF") and Rockford Health System ("RHS") had executed an affiliation agreement which, if consummated, would violate Siem 7 of the Clation Act, as mended, 15 U.S.C. § 18. Complaint Coursel and Respondents have now filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss Complaint, which states that the Recondents are bandoning he proposed faliation, and have with drawn the Hat-Scott-Rodino Notification and Report Fins they filed for the proposed fansation.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission has determined to dismisse Administrative Complaint without prejudice as the most important elements of **thelie**f set out in the Notice of Contemplate Relief in the Administrative Complaint havedmeaccomplished without the needffurther administrative litigation. In particular, Respondents havemnounce that they are abandoning

the proposed faliation, and havewithdrawn the Hart-Scott-Rodino Notification and Report Forms filed for the proposed transaction. As a consequence, the Respondents would not be able to effect the propose transation without filing new Hart-Scott-Rodino Notification and Report Forms.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission has determined that the public interest warrants dismissal of the Administrative Complainthinstmatter. The Commission has determined to do so without prejudice, howee, because it is not reaching a decision on the merits. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED THAT the Administrative Complaint inhits matter be, rad it hereby is, dismissed without prejudice
